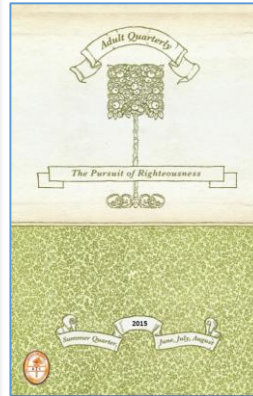

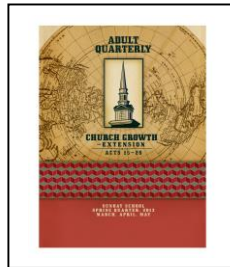


SCRIPTURAL BAPTISMS on Sunday, June 28, 2015.

Putting First Things First

Series: A Time to Build: Lessons from Nehemiah

Scripture: Nehemiah 9:1-37

Summary: In chapter 8, Ezra and Nehemiah comfort the afflicted. In chapter 9, the comfortable are afflicted. Joy and grief are two sides of the same coin. After a thrilling encounter with God, which causes them to break into celebration, the believers now come face to face with their own depravity or sinfulness.

Romans 7:22-25

I) The Greatness of God –Nehemiah 9:1-6 , Leviticus 20:26

"God rests too inconsequentially upon the church. His truth is too distant, his grace too ordinary, his judgment too benign, his gospel too easy, and His Christ too common." - **David Wells**, Nehemiah 9:6, Psalm 19:1.

II) The Goodness of God –Nehemiah 9:7-30.

"He who forgets the past is condemned to repeat it." George Santayana, the Spanish philosopher. Romans 15:4

God's goodness is seen in at least four ways in Nehemiah 9.

1. Forming (7-18).
2. Leading (19-21).
3. Providing (22-25). 2 Peter 1:3
4. Correcting (26-30).

"Deep in our hearts we believe in a good God. Yet how shallow is our understanding of His goodness. How often I have heard people say, 'How good God is! We prayed that it would not rain for our church picnic, and look at the lovely weather!' Yes, God is good when He sends good weather. But God was also good when He allowed my sister Betsie to starve to death before my eyes in a German concentration camp." **Corrie Ten Boom**.

III) The Grace of God - --Nehemiah 9:31-39 , Hebrews 4:14-16

A "binding agreement" a covenant in 3 ways.

1. Personal. What do you need to do this afternoon?
2. Practical. Secondly, based on who He is, what is the Holy Spirit prompting you to do right now? What practical step does He want you to implement?
3. Public. Thirdly, how can you make your decision public? If you're a believer and have never been baptized, you could take that step. Or, you could slip out of your chair during our invitation song and come forward - for confession or for conversion.
