

Making Investments that Last

Series: A Time to Build: Lessons from Nehemiah Scripture: Nehemiah 10:1-39

Summary: This afternoon we're going to learn about 4 vows, or promises, that the people of God made in Nehemiah 10.

Numbers 30:2 Ecclesiastes 5:4 Matthew 5:33-37. Exodus 24, Mark 14:29 But Peter said unto him, Although all shall be offended, yet will not I. Mark 14:71

Are vows of any use today? least two reasons: First, they help us focus. Second, vows allow us to express our love. Jeremiah 31:32,33, Mark 14:24, 1 Corinthians 11:28

The Israelites made 4 vows or promises. Nehemiah 10:29

Vow #1: Submission to God's Word. 2 Chronicles 16:9

Vow #2: Separation From the World -Nehemiah 10:30

There were at least **two reasons** why marriages with pagan people were disastrous.

First, there were clear biblical warnings. Jos 23:13. **Secondly**, there was abundant historical evidence that unequally yoked marriages led to a decline in Israel's spiritual and moral life. Nehemiah 13:26, 2 Corinthians 6:14, 1 Peter 3:1-6. 1 Peter 3:2, 3

Vow #3: Sabbath for God's People. Nehemiah 10:31

First, this day was set aside to honor God. **Secondly**, it was a day of rest Exodus 20:11: "He rested on the seventh day." **Thirdly**, it was a day to help others. **Fourthly**, the Sabbath was a day to declare truth. Matthew 6:33

Vow #4: Support For God's Work 7 insights into how our giving can support God's work today.

1. It was responsible giving. Look at verse 32 and verse 35 where the people say that "they assume responsibility..." 2. It was obedient giving. 3. It was systematic. 1 Corinthians 16:2 4. It was proportionate. Leviticus 5:11 1 Corinthians 16 and 2 Corinthians 8-9. 5. It was sacrificial. 6. It was comprehensive. 7. It was prescribed.
